Non-Profit Child Care and Education Facilities



Eligible Activities

CDBG funds will be utilized towards:

- Non-Profit Child Care and Education Facilities – either new building or rehabilitation
 - Designed to address the childcare shortage in the State of Kansas
 - At least 51% of the children must be from low to moderate income households, verified through self-certification

Grant Amounts

Up to \$3 Million Dollars in funding

Available Funding	
Maximum for <5,000 population	\$600,000
Maximum for >5,000 population	\$750,000
Administration	Up to \$25,000
Match	25%

Application deadline is May 1, 2023

Eligible Activities

CDBG funds will be utilized towards:

- Employment Training
 - Increase:
 - Self-sufficiency
 - Literacy
 - Independent living skills
 - Resume writing
 - Job coaching
 - Job retention
 - Training in specific fields

Eligible Participants of Activities

- At least 51% of the beneficiaries must be LMI persons
 - Income qualified
 - Recipients must demonstrate that 51% of participants are at or below 80% of the average median income for the county in which the student and their family reside

Grant Amounts

Up to \$500,000 in funding

Available Funding	
Maximum Per Awarded	\$100,000
Administration	\$5,000
Match	25%

Application deadline is May 1, 2023
